Secondary Schools Art Competition

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition is open to all students at a secondary school in the Wellington Region who complete an original artwork in the required theme "Land, Sea and Air" in accordance with these terms and conditions.
2. There will be ten finalists and from those finalists one overall winner and nine runners-up.
3. The winning entrant and the nine runners up entries will each receive two adult show day tickets to the 2010 NZ Art Show for Saturday 31st July (children under 13 are free).
4. The winning entrant receives: a \$300 deposit into an ASB Headstart Account from ASB Bank Limited (ASB) and an "artist's package" from the New Zealand Affordable Arts Trust. The nine runners up receive a \$50 deposit into an ASB Headstart Account. Where the winner does not have an ASB Headstart Account one will need to be opened in the winner's name in order to receive the prize. Opening the account is subject to ASB's account opening criteria and will involve a visit to an ASB Branch to complete the necessary forms and provide identification. ASB's Personal Banking Terms and Conditions apply and are available together with ASB's current Disclosure Statement free of charge from any ASB branch. Should the prize winner be under 15 years of age a Parent or Guardian will be required to open an account for them.
5. Entries may use any media but must be original artwork produced by the entrant. The artwork must not contain brands, logos or any other person's work or intellectual property. Entrants must ensure they have permission for the use of an image if it shows an identifiable person.
6. Entries must be received by Friday 5 March 2010. Only one entry per person.
7. Individual entries must be delivered to any of the following ASB Branches:
 - a) ASB Manners Street
 - b) ASB Lambton Quay
 - c) ASB Wellington
 - d) ASB Queensgate
 - e) ASB North City Porriua
 - f) ASB Paraparumu
 - g) ASB Johnsonville
8. School's class entries can be collected by NZ Affordable Art Trust by phoning the number below.
9. Entries must be wrapped and clearly marked NZ Art Competition 2010.
10. Entries must have an artwork submission sheet attached signed by parent or caregiver if the entrant is under 18 years of age.
11. The winner and runners-up will be notified by telephone at the phone number provided on the entry form no later than 31 March 2010. Failure to provide correct contact details may result in the prize being assigned to another entrant.
12. The winning and the runners-up entries will be on display at the 2010 NZ Art Show.
13. The winner and runners-up may also choose to sell their art entries in the 2010 NZ Art Show should they wish to.
14. Art will be returned by the NZ Affordable Art Trust to schools or directly to entrants by 1st September 2010.
15. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The judges reserve the right to remove any person from the prize draw for any reason including, but not limited to, where the conditions for entry to the competition have not been met.
16. The prizes are not transferable.
17. All personal information collected by New Zealand Affordable Art Trust is for the purpose of this competition and will be destroyed at the end of the competition. This information will be held by The Beach House Gallery, 5 Lyall Parade, Lyall Bay, Wellington, and entrants have rights of access to and correction of it.
18. To the extent permitted by law, ASB, NZ Affordable Art Trust, their employees and agents shall not be liable for any claims, damages, injuries, costs and expenses suffered, sustained or incurred (including but not limited to indirect or consequential) as a result of, or arises out, or in anyway connected with this competition or its prizes.
19. The winner and runners up maybe required for publicity purposes reasonably required by ASB or NZ Affordable Art Trust.
